
I am writing to you for a few reasons; first of all please let me apologize for not being truthful in your court. I made a serious mistake that has cause pain to my sister and the two people that were the only family my husband realized. I will never be able to take their pain away and for that I am most sorry. This mistake was made at a time when I was consumed in pain from losing the man I loved and the fear I had of his mother. I have lived my life abiding by the law and helping others and I know my state of mind was no excuse I just needed to apologize for my decisions.

Secondly I need to inform you that I cannot afford an attorney for the hearing regarding the Petition Interim Taxable Costs and Attorney's Fees. I am not sure how to proceed so I will simply explain why I feel Ms Sanservino has no right to ask for additional monies.

1. Ms Sanservino petitioned the Maryland courts to take charge of my husband's estate. She was granted this and has sold the house he owned in his name. She has not contacted me and has kept all proceeds. The mortgage for this house was paid by me for three years totaling around \$36,000.00. When I requested permission to sell the house two years ago she declined and I could no longer pay the mortgage. I had just lost the house in Souderton that we both owned the previous year due to the financial strain. I left all my husband's belongings in the house so she received those as well. She has realized more than \$80,000.00 from the sale of the house and his personal items. This is more than enough to pay for her legal fees and cover what she would have inherited.
2. The legal fees Ms Sanservino included in her expenses included expenses from a lawyer that was hired to try and prove that her accusations regarding my husband's death were correct. These accusations were found to be inaccurate and still she posts them on her website dedicated to discrediting me and the Souderton's coroner's office. These expenses had nothing to do with my husband's will and should not be factored in to this petition.
